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About the Project The Florida Department of Transportation's (FDOT) contractor is removing (milling) and resurfacing (paving) the asphalt travel lanes of I-75 from Lockhart Road to the Withlacoochee River Bridge in Hernando County.

The project also includes resurfacing 3 of the 4 ramps at the State Road 50 (Cortez Blvd.) interchange. Closures on these ramps will be limited and will happen during the regular closure hours, Monday through Thursday nights. Only the southbound I-75 Exit 301 to State Road 50 will NOT be resurfaced.

Traffic Flow The construction phasing is designed so that all existing lanes of traffic and interchange ramps will be open on I-75 during peak traffic hours.

Lane Closure Hours Lane closures and ramp closures are allowed on this project from 7:30 p.m. to 7:30 a.m. as needed.

Night Work In order to maintain the construction schedule and to minimize the impact to the traveling public, lane closures and construction work are planned for nighttime hours.
