The project includes adding lanes in each direction, shifting the roadway alignment near Tampa North Aero Park, extensive drainage construction, some overhead signing, and high mast lighting.

When finished, there will be 3 through-lanes in each direction, plus one auxiliary lane in each direction between State Road 56 and County Road 54. The auxiliary lanes will help handle the traffic entering and exiting the highway at the interchanges and at the rest areas.

Improvement Highlights

- Widen the interstate from 4 to 8 lanes.
- Improved drainage.
- Tie in to the completed interstate projects at the County Road 54 interchange, the rest areas and the State Road 56 interchange.

Traffic Flow The construction phasing is designed so that all existing lanes of traffic and interchange ramps will be open on I-75 during peak traffic hours.

Lane Closure Hours Lane closures and ramp closures are allowed on this project from 8 p.m. to 5 a.m. as needed.

Night Work In order to maintain the construction schedule and to minimize the impact to the traveling public, lane closures and construction work are planned for nighttime hours.



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
