Project news: Northbound I-275 Connector to CR 296 / SR 686

Night lane closures on northbound I-275 approaching Roosevelt Boulevard

ST. PETERSBURG -- One to two lanes will be closed on northbound I-275 between Gandy Boulevard (Exit 28) and Ulmerton Road (Exit 31) from 8 p.m. to 5:30 a.m. Sunday through Thursday (November 7 - 11) nights.

Southbound I-275 exit to CR 296 to be closed early mornings

ST. PETERSBURG -- The portion of southbound I-275 Exit 30 that connects to County Road 296 (118th Avenue) will be closed from 12:01 a.m. to 5:30 a.m. Tuesday through Friday (November 9 - 12) mornings.

DETOURS: Use Exit 31 and take Ulmerton Road (State Road 688) west to Roosevelt Boulevard (State Road 686), go east on Roosevelt, then turn right on 28th Street North and continue to County Road 296 / 118th Avenue. Another option is to exit at Exit 30, go west on Roosevelt, then turn left on 28th Street North and continue to County Road 296 / 118th Avenue.

Project news: Northbound I-275 Exit Ramps to State Road 60

Night lane closures on I-275 near Howard Frankland

TAMPA -- One to two lanes will be closed on northbound I-275 between the east end of the Howard Frankland Bridge and Exit 39 (State Road 60) between 9 p.m. and 5 a.m. Sunday through Thursday (November 7 - 11) nights.

Project news: I-4 /Selmon Expressway Connector

Night lane closures and traffic shift on I-4

TAMPA -- One to two lanes will be closed from west of 21st Street (Exit 1) to 50th Street (Exit 3) from 8 p.m. to 6 a.m. Sunday through Friday (November 7 - 12) nights. By the end of the week, all lanes of traffic are expected to be shifted to the right for upcoming construction phases.

Night and day lane closures on Selmon Expressway

TAMPA -- One lane may be closed in both directions of the Selmon Expressway (SR 618) from 22nd Street (Exit 9) to 50th Street (Exit 11) from 7 p.m. to 5 a.m. Friday night, November 5 and Sunday through Friday (Nov. 7 - 12) nights and from 10 a.m. to 4 p.m. Saturday (Nov. 6) and Monday through Saturday (Nov. 8 - 13).

Night and day lane closures/flagging on Adamo Drive

TAMPA -- One lane may be closed in each direction of State Road 60 (Adamo Drive) between 26th and 50th streets from 7 p.m. to 5 a.m. Friday night, November 5 and Sunday through Friday (Nov. 7 - 12) nights. There will be daytime closures and some flagging operations in the same area from 10 a.m. to 4 p.m. Saturday (Nov. 6) and Monday through Saturday (Nov. 8 - 13).

Night and day lane closures on 20th, 21st & 22nd streets near Selmon Expressway/SR 60

TAMPA (YBOR CITY) -- One to two (of three) lanes may be closed on State Road 45 (20th, 21st and 22nd streets) from State Road 60 to Grant Street from 7 p.m. to 5 a.m. Friday night, November 5 and Sunday through Friday (Nov. 7 - 12) nights and from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. Saturday (Nov. 6) and Monday through Saturday (Nov. 8 - 13).

Day lane closures on 4th Avenue

TAMPA -- There will be lane closures and traffic flagging operations on 4th Avenue between 28th and 31st streets from 7 a.m. to 6 p.m. Monday through Saturday (November 8 - 13).

Day lane closures on 34th Street near SR 60

TAMPA -- One lane will be closed on northbound 34th Street from Clark Street to State Road 60 from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m. Monday through Saturday (November 8 - 13).

Lane closed on Durham Street during the day

TAMPA -- One lane will be closed on Durham Street between 20th Street and 31st Street from 7 a.m. to 6 p.m. Monday through Saturday (November 8 - 13) for utility work. Residential traffic will be maintained by flaggers.

Project news: I-75 Slab Repairs from Progress Boulevard to State Road 60

Westbound SR 60 ramp onto southbound I-75 to be closed at night week of Nov. 8

BRANDON -- The westbound State Road 60 entrance ramp onto southbound I-75 will be closed from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m. Monday through Thursday (November 8 - 11) nights. *[Closures previously scheduled for Friday through Sunday (Nov. 5-7) nights have been canceled.]*

DETOUR: Continue west on SR 60. U-turn at Falkenburg Road, head east on SR 60 then use the eastbound SR 60 ramp to southbound I-75.

Northbound U.S. 301 entrance to southbound I-75 to be closed weekend of November 12

BRANDON -- The northbound U.S. Highway 301 entrance ramp onto southbound I-75 will be closed from 11 p.m. Friday (November 12) to 5 a.m. Monday (November 15).

DETOUR: Traffic will continue north on U.S. 301, make a u-turn at the signalized intersection at Crescent Park Drive, then go south on U.S. 301 and use that entrance ramp to southbound I-75.

Project news: I-75/I-275 Exit Ramps to State Road 56

Night lane closures on I-75 at I-275

NEW TAMPA -- The right lane of I-75 will be closed in each direction from just south of I-275 to south of State Road 56 (Exit 275) from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m. Friday night, November 5 and Sunday through Friday (November 7 - 12) nights.
