Interstate construction closures and news for the night of November 4 – November 12, 2011

Project news: I-4 /Selmon Expressway Connector

Nightly and Weekend closures scheduled for Selmon and Meridian entrance to the Reversible Express Lanes

TAMPA -- Closures with detours are scheduled for the westbound Selmon Expressway (SR 618) and the Reversible Express Lanes (REL) entrance at Meridian Avenue as listed below. If the schedule changes, updates will be posted at our myTBI.com web site.

The detours will happen between 50th Street (Exit 11) and 22nd Street (Exit 9) for the westbound lower level. The Reversible Express Lanes (which carry traffic only in the eastbound direction at night) will be closed from the entrance at Meridian Avenue to the slip ramp just west of U.S. 301.

- 7 p.m. Sunday (11/6) to 5 a.m. Monday (11/7): Westbound closed; REL Meridian entrance closed.
- 8 p.m. Monday (11/7) to 5 a.m. Tuesday (11/8): Westbound closed; REL Meridian entrance closed.
- 8 p.m. Tuesday (11/8) to 5 a.m. Wednesday (11/9): Westbound closed; REL Meridian entrance closed.
- 8 p.m. Wednesday (11/9) to 5 a.m. Thursday (11/10): Westbound closed.
- 8 p.m. Thursday (11/10) to 5 a.m. Friday (11/11): Westbound closed; REL Meridian entrance closed.
- 8 p.m. Friday (11/11) to 11 a.m. Saturday (11/12): Westbound closed; REL Meridian entrance closed

WESTBOUND DETOUR: Westbound traffic will be directed off the Selmon Expressway at 50th Street (Exit 11), detoured west on SR 60 (Adamo Drive), then back onto the Expressway using the 21st/22nd Street entrance ramp. Tolls will be suspended for entering the westbound Selmon at 22nd Street during detour hours only.

DETOUR FOR REVERSIBLE EXPRESS LANES: The first opportunity for eastbound drivers to enter the REL from the lower level of the Selmon Expressway will be at the slip ramp located just west of U.S. Highway 301.

Reversible Express Lanes Veterans Day Hours

TAMPA -- The Reversible Express Lanes (REL) on the Selmon Expressway will open in the westbound direction (toward downtown) at the normal time of 6 a.m. on Friday, November 11. At 10 a.m., traffic on the entire REL will

be reversed to the eastbound direction (toward Brandon) and will remain in the eastbound direction until 6 a.m., Monday, November 14.

Day and night lane closures on eastbound Selmon Expressway

TAMPA -- One lane may be closed on the eastbound Selmon Expressway (SR 618) between 22nd Street (Exit 9) and 50th Street (Exit 11) from 9 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. Saturday, November 5 and Monday through Saturday (November 7 - 12), and from 8 p.m. to 5 a.m. Monday through Thursday (November 7 - 10) nights.

Night lane closures on I-4 between Exits 1 and 3

TAMPA -- The left lane may be closed on eastbound and westbound I-4 between 22nd Street (Exit 1) and 50th Street (Exit 3) from 8 p.m. to 6 a.m. Monday through Sunday (November 7 - 13) nights.

7th Avenue to be closed at night

TAMPA -- 7th Avenue will be closed between the railroad tracks (east of 26th St.) and 31st St. from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m. Monday through Friday (November 7 - 11) nights. Motorists can use 34th Street, State Road 60, and 21st/22nd streets to detour around the closed area.

Day and night lane closures on 20th, 21st & 22nd streets near Selmon Expressway/SR 60

TAMPA -- One lane may be closed each way on 20th, 21st and 22nd streets from State Road 60 to Linsey Street from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. Saturday (November 5) and Monday through Saturday (November 7 - 12), and from 7 p.m. to 6 a.m. Monday through Thursday (November 7 - 10) nights.

26th Street down to one lane or detoured under I-4

TAMPA -- 26th Street may be closed between 13th and 14th avenues (under I-4) from 10:30 p.m. to 6 a.m. one or more nights Wednesday through Sunday (November 9 - 13) nights (the detour is posted on the myTBI.com web site). 26th Street will be reduced to one lane between 12th and 15th avenues, with traffic flagged through, from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. Saturday, November 5 and Monday through Saturday (November 7 - 12). Traffic will also be reduced to one lane from 7 p.m. to 5 a.m. Monday through Thursday (November 7 - 10) nights (unless a detour is in place).

Day and night lane closures on 34th Street at SR 60

TAMPA -- One lane will be closed in both directions of 34th Street from State Road 60 (Adamo Drive) to Grace Street from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. Saturday, November 5 and Monday through Saturday (November 7 - 12), and from 7 p.m. to 5 a.m. Monday through Thursday (November 7 - 10) nights.

Project news: I-75 Widening from Fowler Avenue to State Road 56

Night lane closures on I-75 in northern Hillsborough County

TAMPA -- One lane will be closed in both directions of I-75 in various locations from south of Fowler Avenue (Exit 265) to just north of the Hillsborough River (about 1.5 miles north of Fletcher Avenue, Exit 266) Sunday through Thursday (November 6 - 10) nights. Southbound closures will be from 10:30 p.m. to 5 a.m.; northbound lane closures will be from 11 p.m. to 6 a.m.

Sunday night lane closures on Fowler Avenue in I-75 area

TAMPA -- One lane will be closed in both directions of Fowler Avenue, from east of I-75 to west of the Hillsborough River from 9 p.m. Sunday (November 6) to 6 a.m. Monday (November 7).

Night lane closures on Fletcher Avenue in I-75 area

TAMPA -- One lane will be closed in both directions of Fletcher Avenue, from Old Morris Bridge Road to the northbound I-75 ramps from 9 p.m. to 6 a.m. Sunday through Thursday (November 6 - 10) nights.

Project news: I-75/I-275 Exit Ramps to State Road 56

Night lane closures on northbound I-75 at I-275

WESLEY CHAPEL -- One lane will be closed on northbound I-75 from south of the I-275 overpass to State Road 56 from 8 p.m. to 5 a.m. Sunday through Thursday (November 6 - 10) nights.

Night lane closures on northbound I-275 approaching I-75

WESLEY CHAPEL -- One lane will be closed on northbound I-275 from one-half mile south of I-75 to State Road 56 from 8 p.m. to 5 a.m. Sunday through Thursday (November 6 - 10) nights.

Project news: I-75 Widening from State Road 56 to County Road 54

Nightly lane closures on I-75 in southern Pasco

WESLEY CHAPEL -- One lane of northbound or southbound I-75 may be closed between State Road 56 (Exit 275) and County Road/State Road 54 (Exit 279) from 8 p.m. to 5 a.m. Sunday through Wednesday (November 6 - 9) nights.

Project news: I-75 Resurfacing from Lockhart Road to the Withlacoochee River

Night lane closures on I-75 in Hernando County

HERNANDO COUNTY -- One lane may be closed in either direction of I-75 between Lockhart Road and the Withlacoochee River from 7:30 p.m. to 7:30 a.m. Sunday through Thursday (November 6 - 10) nights.
